## Background

## Workplan

The work involves copy editing a 250+ page book, which needs to be completed within a 10-day period over the course of September.

## Timeline

This work must be carried out in September. It will include one review of all copy-edited content with feedback provided by reviewers, followed by a second round of copy-editing work to integrate all feedback.

Global Canopy has an allocated budget for this position. Day rates and anticipated number of days to be spent on the project are open for discussion based on experience.
